RESOLUTION

To refer S. 1335 entitled "A bill for the relief of the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin" to the Chief Judge of the United States Claims Court for a report thereon.

1 *Resolved*, That S. 1335 entitled "A bill for the relief
2 of the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin" now pend-
3 ing in the Senate, together with all the accompanying pa-
4 pers, is referred to the Chief Judge of the United States
5 Claims Court. The Chief Judge shall proceed according
6 to the provisions of sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28,
7 United States Code, and report back to the Senate, at the
8 earliest practicable date, providing such findings of fact
9 and conclusions that are sufficient to inform the Congress

1 of the nature, extent, and character of the damages re-
2 ferred to in such bill as a legal or equitable claim against
3 the United States or a gratuity, and the amount, if any,
4 legally or equitably due from the United States to the Me-
5 nominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin by reason of such dam-
6 ages.
