RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate that a commemorative postage stamp should be issued to honor coach Paul “Bear” Bryant.

Whereas eleven years after his death, Paul “Bear” Bryant retains the record of being the most successful coach in Division 1–A college football history;

Whereas Paul “Bear” Bryant’s accomplishments were a source of great pride to the University of Alabama and the Nation;

Whereas Paul “Bear” Bryant’s example has profoundly influenced many professional and collegiate coaches and players; and

Whereas Paul “Bear” Bryant is a modern hero and legend in the South: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the Senate that the

3 Postal Service should recommend to the Postmaster Gen-
4 eral that a postage stamp be issued honoring coach Paul
