## RESOLUTION

To refer S. 974 entitled “A bill for the relief of Richard Kanehl of Mobile, Alabama.” to the chief judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims for a report thereon.

1       *Resolved*, That, as a supplement to S. Res. 108 of  
2 the 103d Congress, the bill S. 974 entitled “A bill for the  
3 relief of Richard Kanehl of Mobile, Alabama.” now pend-  
4 ing in the Senate, together with all the accompanying pa-  
5 pers, is referred to the chief judge of the United States  
6 Court of Federal Claims. The chief judge shall proceed  
7 with the same in accordance with the provisions of sections  
8 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code, notwith-

1 standing the bar of any statute of limitations, laches, res  
2 judicata, collateral estoppel, or bar of sovereign immunity,  
3 and report thereon to the Senate, at the earliest prac-  
4 ticable date, giving such findings of fact and conclusions  
5 thereon as shall be sufficient to inform the Congress of  
6 the nature and character of the demand as a claim, legal  
7 or equitable, against the United States or a gratuity and  
8 the amount, if any, legally or equitably due to the claim-  
9 ants from the United States. In complying with this reso-  
10 lution, the Court of Federal Claims is requested to con-  
11 sider the records of any previous trial of the issues in this  
12 case, including the records of Merchants National Bank  
13 v. United States (7 Cl. Ct. 1; 1984).
