To amend Senate Resolution 75, 103d Congress, relating to the Jacob K. Javits Senate Fellowship Program.

Mr. MITCHELL (for himself and Mr. DOLE) submitted the following resolution;
which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To amend Senate Resolution 75, 103d Congress, relating
to the Jacob K. Javits Senate Fellowship Program.

1 *Resolved*, That Senate Resolution 75 (103d Congress,
2 1st Session), agreed to March 3, 1993, is amended—

3 (1) in section 2, by adding at the end thereof
4 the following:

5 “(c) The Jacob K. Javits Foundation, Incorporated
6 shall—

7 “(1) broadly publicize the availability of the fel-
8 lowship program;

9 “(2) develop and administer an application
10 process for Senate fellowships;

1 “(3) conduct a screening of applicants for the
2 fellowship program; and

3 “(4) select participants without regard to race,
4 color, religion, sex, National origin, age, or disabili-
5 ty.”;

6 (2) in section 3, by amending subsection (c) to
7 read as follows:

8 “(c) The Secretary, after consultation with the Ma-
9 jority Leader and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall
10 assist with the placement of eligible participants in posi-
11 tions in the Senate that are, within practical consider-
12 ations, supportive of the fellowship participants’ academic
13 programs. Fellows shall be considered as employees of the
14 office or committee in which they are placed.”; and

15 (3) in section 5, by inserting “the Minority
16 Leader of” before “the Senate”.
