Mr. MITCHELL (for himself and Mr. DOLE) submitted the following resolution;
which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Authorizing the taking of a photograph in the Chamber
of the United States Senate.

1 *Resolved*, That paragraph 1 of Rule IV of the Rules
2 for the Regulation of the Senate Wing of the United
3 States Capitol (prohibiting the taking of pictures in the
4 Senate Chamber) be temporarily suspended for the sole
5 and specific purpose of permitting an official photograph
6 to be taken of the United States Senate in actual session
7 on a date and time to be announced by the Majority Lead-
8 er after consultation with the Republican Leader.

9 SEC. 2. The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate is au-
10 thorized and directed to make the necessary arrangements

- 1 therefor, which arrangements shall provide for a minimum
- 2 of disruption to Senate proceedings.
