Mr. MITCHELL submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To amend paragraph 4 of rule XXV of the Standing Rules of the Senate.

1 *Resolved*, That paragraph 4 of rule XXV is amended
2 by striking (h)(1) through (h) (15) and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:

4 “(h)(1) A Senator who on the last day of the One
5 Hundred Second Congress was serving as a member of
6 the Committee on Environment and Public Works and the
7 Committee on Finance may, during the One Hundred
8 Third Congress, also serve as a member of the Committee
9 on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry so long as his
10 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
11 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,

1 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
2 graph 2.

3 “(2) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
4 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
5 Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on En-
6 ergy and Natural Resources may, during the One Hun-
7 dred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the Com-
8 mittee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
9 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
10 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
11 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
12 graph 2.

13 “(3) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
14 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
15 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs and
16 the Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the One
17 Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the
18 Committee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
19 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
20 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
21 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
22 graph 2.

23 “(4) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
24 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
25 Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and

1 the Committee on Appropriations may, during the One
2 Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the
3 Committee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
4 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
5 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
6 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
7 graph 2.

8 “(5)(A) A Senator who on the last day of the One
9 Hundred Second Congress was serving as a member of
10 the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on
11 the Judiciary may, during the One Hundred Third Con-
12 gress, also serve as a member of the Committee on Labor
13 and Human Resources so long as his service as a member
14 of each such committee is continuous, but in no event may
15 he serve by reason of this subdivision, as a member of
16 more than three committees listed in paragraph 2.

17 “(B) A Senator who during the One Hundred Third
18 Congress serves on the Committee on Armed Services, the
19 Committee on the Judiciary, and the Committee on Labor
20 and Human Resources, and who serves as chairman of a
21 committee listed in paragraph 2, may serve as chairman
22 of two subcommittees of all committees listed in paragraph
23 2 of which he is a member.

24 “(6) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
25 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the

1 Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation and
2 the Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the One
3 Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the
4 Committee on Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs so
5 long as his service as a member of each such committee
6 is continuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason
7 of this subdivision, as a member of more than three com-
8 mittees listed in paragraph 2.

9 “(7)(A) A Senator who on the last day of the One
10 Hundred Second Congress was serving as a member of
11 the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry
12 and the Committee on Appropriations may, during the
13 One Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of
14 the Committee on the Judiciary so long as his service as
15 a member of each such committee is continuous, but in
16 no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision as
17 a member of more than three committees listed in para-
18 graph 2.

19 “(B) A Senator who during the One Hundred Third
20 Congress serves on the Committee on Agriculture, Nutri-
21 tion, and Forestry, the Committee on Appropriations and
22 the Committee on the Judiciary, and who serves as chair-
23 man of a committee listed in paragraph 2, may serve as
24 chairman of two subcommittees of all committees listed
25 in paragraph 2 of which he is a member.

1 “(8) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
2 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
3 Committee on Environment and Public Works and the
4 Committee on the Judiciary may, during the One Hundred
5 Third Congress, also serve as a member of the Committee
6 on Labor and Human Resources so long as his service as
7 a member of each such committee is continuous, but in
8 no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as
9 a member of more than three committees listed in para-
10 graph 2.

11 “(9) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
12 dred Second Congress was serving on the Committee on
13 Environment and Public Works and the Committee on Fi-
14 nance may, during the One Hundred Third Congress, also
15 serve as a member of the Committee on Foreign Relations
16 so long as his service as a member of each such committee
17 is continuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason
18 of this subdivision, as a member of more than three com-
19 mittees listed in paragraph 2.

20 “(B) A Senator who during the One Hundred Third
21 Congress serves on the Committee on Environment and
22 Public Works, the Committee on Finance, and the Com-
23 mittee on Foreign Relations, and who serves as chairman
24 of a committee listed in paragraph 2, may serve as chair-

1 man of two subcommittees of all committees listed in para-
2 graph 2 of which he is a member.

3 “(10) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
4 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
5 Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and
6 the Committee on Finance may, during the One Hundred
7 Third Congress, also serve as a member of the Committee
8 on Governmental Affairs so long as his service as a mem-
9 ber of each such committee is continuous but in no event
10 may he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as a member
11 of more than three committees listed in paragraph 2.

12 “(11) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
13 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
14 Committee on Appropriations and the Committee on
15 Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs may, during the
16 One Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of
17 the Committee on Governmental Affairs so long as his
18 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
19 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
20 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
21 graph 2.

22 “(12) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
23 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
24 Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on
25 Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs may, during the

1 One Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of
2 the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources so long
3 as his service as a member of each such committee is con-
4 tinuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason of this
5 subdivision, as a member of more than three committees
6 listed in paragraph 2.

7 “(13) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
8 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
9 Committee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Labor
10 and Human Resources may, during the One Hundred
11 Third Congress, also serve as a member of the Committee
12 on Foreign Relations so long as his service as a member
13 of each such committee is continuous, but in no event may
14 he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as a member of
15 more than three committees in paragraph 2.

16 “(14) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
17 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
18 Committee on Environment and Public Works and the
19 Committee on Governmental Affairs may, during the One
20 Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the
21 Committee on Armed Services so long as his service as
22 a member of each such committee is continuous, but in
23 no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as
24 a member of more than three committees listed in para-
25 graph 2.

1 “(15) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
2 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
3 Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation
4 and the Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the
5 One Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of
6 the Committee on Armed Services so long as his service
7 as a member of each such committee is continuous, but
8 in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
9 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
10 graph 2.

11 “(16) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
12 dred Second Congress was serving as a member of the
13 Committee on Environment and Public Works and the
14 Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the One
15 Hundred Third Congress, also serve as a member of the
16 Committee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
17 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
18 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
19 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
20 graph 2.
