3 SENATE COMPONENT OF FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

4 SEC. 3. (a) The Secretary of the Senate (hereinafter  
5 "Secretary") is authorized from funds made available  
6 under section 4, to appoint and fix the compensation of  
7 each eligible participant selected under section 2 for a pe-  
8 riod determined by the Secretary. The period of employ-  
9 ment for each participant shall not exceed one year. Com-  
10 pensation paid to participants under this resolution shall  
11 not supplement stipends received from the Secretary of  
12 Education under the Fellowship Program.

13 (b) For any fiscal year no more than ten fellowship  
14 participants shall be so employed.

15 (c) The Secretary, after consultation with the major-  
16 ity leader and the minority leader of the Senate, shall  
17 place eligible participants in positions in the Senate that  
18 are, within practical considerations, supportive of the fel-  
19 lowship participants' academic programs.

20 FUNDS

21 SEC. 4. The funds necessary to compensate any such  
22 eligible participant shall be made available for five years  
23 to the Secretary and paid from the contingent fund of the  
24 Senate. For the succeeding five years of this program such  
25 funds shall not exceed \$250,000 each year.

## 1 PROGRAM EXTENSION

2 SEC. 5. This program shall terminate September 30,  
3 1998. Three months prior to such expiration the Secretary  
4 shall submit a report evaluating the program to the Major-  
5 ity Leader and the Senate along with recommendations  
6 concerning the program's extension and continued funding  
7 level.

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
