submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

## RESOLUTION

To authorize testimony and to authorize representation by  
the Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, the defendants in *Kofoed v. Swanson-Nunn Electric Company, et al.*, No. 9209-06644, pending in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County, seek the deposition testimony of Suzanne Beede, a Senate employee on the staff of Senator Hatfield;

Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States and rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate can, by administrative or judicial process, be taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate;

Whereas, when it appears that evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate is needed for the pro-

motion of justice, the Senate will taken such action as well promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(2) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (2 U.S.C. 288b(a) and 288c(a)(2)), the Senate may direct its counsel to represent employees of the Senate with respect to requests for testimony made to them in their official capacities: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That Suzanne Beede is authorized to testify  
2 in *Kofoed v. Swanson-Nunn Electric Company, et al.*, No.  
3 9209-06644 (Or. Cir. Ct.), except concerning matters for  
4 which a privilege should be asserted.

5       SEC. 2. The Senate Legal Counsel is authorized to  
6 represent Suzanne Beede in connection with the testimony  
7 authorized by section 1 of this resolution.
