RESOLUTION

To refer S. 745 entitled “A Bill for the Relief of Hardwick, Inc.,” to the Chief Judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims.

1 *Resolved*, That the bill S. 745 entitled “A Bill for the
2 Relief of Hardwick, Inc.” now pending in the Senate, to-
3 gether with all accompanying papers, is referred to the
4 Chief Judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims.
5 The Chief Judge shall proceed with consideration of such
6 case in accordance with the provisions of sections 1492
7 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code (notwithstanding
8 any other appeal, statute, case law, or regulations, includ-
9 ing section 1500 of title 28, United States Code, that may
10 limit in any way the jurisdiction or authority of the court),

1 and report thereon to the Senate at the earliest practicable
2 date giving findings of fact and conclusions thereon as
3 shall be sufficient to inform the Congress of the nature
4 and character of the demand as a claim, legal or equitable
5 against the United States, and the amount, if any, legally
6 or equitably due to the claimants from the United States.
