Mr. ARMEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an Adjournment of both Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in consonance with section 132(a) of
3 the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, when the
4 House adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, August
5 1, 1996, Friday, August 2, 1996, or Saturday, August 3,
6 1996, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority Leader
7 or his designee, it stand adjourned until noon on Wednes-
8 day, September 4, 1996, or until noon on the second day
9 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
10 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first;
11 and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at the close
12 of business on Thursday, August 1, 1996, Friday, August

1 2, 1996, Saturday, August 3, 1996, or Sunday, August
2 4, 1996, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority Lead-
3 er or his designee in accordance with this resolution, it
4 stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, Sep-
5 tember 3, 1996, or until such time on that day as may
6 be specified by the Majority Leader or his designee in the
7 motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second
8 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
9 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
10 first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
15 and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
16 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
