

In the Senate of the United States,

October 3, 1996.

Resolved, That the resolution from the House of Representatives (H. Con. Res. 230) entitled “Concurrent resolution providing for the sine die adjournment of the second session of the One Hundred Fourth Congress.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike out all after the resolving clause and insert:

1 *That when the House adjourns on the legislative day of*
2 *Wednesday, October 2, 1996, Thursday, October 3, 1996,*
3 *or Friday, October 4, 1996, on a motion offered pursuant*
4 *to this concurrent resolution by the Majority Leader, or his*
5 *designee, it stand adjourned sine die, or until noon on the*
6 *second day after Members are notified to reassemble pursu-*
7 *ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, and that when*
8 *the Senate adjourns on Wednesday, October 2, 1996, Thurs-*
9 *day, October 3, 1996, or Friday, October 4, 1996, on a mo-*
10 *tion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by the*

1 *Majority Leader, or his designee, it stand adjourned sine*
2 *die, or until noon on the second day after Members are noti-*
3 *fied to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent*
4 *resolution.*

5 *SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority*
6 *Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with*
7 *the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Leader*
8 *of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and*
9 *Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their opin-*
10 *ion, the public interest shall warrant it.*
