CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Waiving provisions of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1970 requiring adjournment of Congress by July 31.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
3 tion 132(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946
4 (2 U.S.C. 198(a)), the House of Representatives and the
5 Senate shall not adjourn for a period in excess of three
6 days, or adjourn sine die, until both Houses of Congress
7 have adopted a concurrent resolution providing either for
8 an adjournment (in excess of three days) to a day certain
9 or for adjournment sine die.
