CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Friday, August 4, 1995, pursuant to a motion
4 made by the Majority Leader, or his designee, it stand
5 adjourned until noon on Wednesday, September 6, 1995,
6 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified

1 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this resolution,
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
3 or adjourns on any day beginning on Saturday, August
4 5, 1995, through Saturday, August 19, 1995, pursuant
5 to a motion made by the Majority Leader, or his designee,
6 in accordance with this resolution, it stand recessed or ad-
7 journed until noon on Tuesday, September 5, 1995, or
8 until such time on that day as may be specified by the
9 Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
10 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members
11 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this
12 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

13 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
14 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
15 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
16 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
17 and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
18 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
