## A BILL

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Ohio.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of  
5 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) the Federal En-  
6 ergy Regulatory Commission, upon the request of the li-  
7 censee for FERC Project No. 9423 (and after reasonable  
8 notice), is authorized, in accordance with the good faith,  
9 due diligence, and public interest requirements of such  
10 section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such

1 section, to extend the time required for commencement of  
2 construction for the project for up to a maximum of 3  
3 consecutive 2-year periods. This section shall take effect  
4 for the project upon the expiration of the extension (issued  
5 by the Commission under such section 13) of the period  
6 required for commencement of construction of such  
7 project.
