To authorize extension of time limitation for a FERC-issued hydroelectric license.

A BILL

To authorize extension of time limitation for a FERC-issued hydroelectric license.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding the time limitation of section 13 of
4 the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory
5 Commission, upon the request of the licensee for FERC

1 Project No. 3701, is authorized, in accordance with the
2 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements
3 of section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such
4 section, to extend until May 31, 2001, the time required
5 for the licensee to commence the construction of such
6 project. This section shall take effect for the project upon
7 the expiration of the extension (issued by the Commission
8 under section 13) of the period required for commence-
9 ment of construction of such project. If the license for
10 FERC Project 3701 should expire prior to the date of en-
11 actment of this Act, the Commission is authorized and di-
12 rected to reinstate effective June 1, 1995, the license pre-
13 viously issued for such project, to extend until May 31,
14 2001, the time required for the licensee to commence the
15 construction of such project. *That notwithstanding the*
16 *time limitation of section 13 of the Federal Power Act, the*
17 *Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, upon the request*
18 *of the licensee for FERC Project No. 3701, is authorized,*
19 *in accordance with the good faith, due diligence, and public*
20 *interest requirements of section 13 and the Commission's*
21 *procedures under such section, to extend the time required*
22 *for the licensee to commence the construction of such project*
23 *for up to a maximum of 3 consecutive 2-year periods. This*
24 *section shall take effect for the project upon the expiration*
25 *of the extension (issued by the Commission under section*

1 13) of the period required for commencement of construction
2 of such project. If the license for FERC Project 3701 should
3 expire prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-
4 mission is authorized and directed to reinstate effective
5 June 1, 1995, the license previously issued for such project.

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
