AN ACT

To authorize extension of time limitation for a FERC-issued
hydroelectric license.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That notwithstanding the time limitation of section 13 of
4 the Federal Power Act, the Federal Energy Regulatory
5 Commission, upon the request of the licensee for FERC
6 Project No. 3701, is authorized, in accordance with the
7 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements
8 of section 13 and the Commission's procedures under such

1 section, to extend the time required for the licensee to
2 commence the construction of such project for up to a
3 maximum of 3 consecutive 2-year periods. This section
4 shall take effect for the project upon the expiration of the
5 extension (issued by the Commission under section 13) of
6 the period required for commencement of construction of
7 such project. If the license for FERC Project 3701 should
8 expire prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-
9 mission is authorized and directed to reinstate effective
10 June 1, 1995, the license previously issued for such
11 project.
