7 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR 16 AND 17 YEAR OLDS TO**
8 **LOAD MATERIALS INTO BALERS AND COM-**
9 **PACTORS.**

10 *In the administration of the child labor provisions of*
11 *the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, individuals who are*
12 *16 and 17 years of age shall be permitted to load materials*
13 *into cardboard balers and compactors that are safe for the*
14 *16 and 17 year olds loading the equipment and which can-*
15 *not operate while being loaded. For purposes of this section,*
16 *such balers and compactors shall be considered safe for 16*
17 *and 17 year olds loading such equipment if they are in*
18 *compliance with the most current safety standard estab-*
19 *lished by the American National Standards Institute.*
