A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to increase the educational assistance allowance with respect to skills or specialties for which there is a critical shortage of personnel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 16131 of title 10, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(j) In the case of an individual who has a skill or
6 specialty designated by the Secretary concerned as a skill
7 or specialty in which there is a critical shortage of person-
8 nel or for which it is difficult to recruit, the Secretary con-

1 cerned, under regulations prescribed by the Secretary of
2 Defense, may increase the rate of the educational assist-
3 ance allowance applicable to such individual to such rate
4 in excess of the rate prescribed under subparagraphs (A)
5 through (D) of subsection (b)(1) as the Secretary of De-
6 fense considers appropriate, but the amount of any such
7 increase may not exceed \$350 per month.”.
