1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “The Striped Bass Act of
5 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. ATLANTIC STRIPED BASS CONSERVATION ACT**
7 **AMENDMENTS.**

8 Section 7(a) of the Atlantic Striped Bass Conserva-
9 tion Act (Public Law 98–613, 16 U.S.C. 1851 note) is
10 amended by striking “1986” and all that follows through
11 “1994”, and inserting instead “1995 and 1996”.

1 **SEC. 3. ANADROMOUS FISH CONSERVATION ACT AMEND-**
2 **MENTS.**

3 Section 7(d) of the Anadromous Fish Conservation
4 Act (16 U.S.C. 757g(d)) is amended by striking “1991,
5 1992, 1993, and 1994” and inserting instead “1995 and
6 1996”.
