## AN ACT

To provide for the extension of a hydroelectric project located  
in the State of West Virginia.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4        (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
5        specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
6        U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-  
7        ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 7307, the

1 Commission shall, upon the request of the licensee for the  
2 project, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,  
3 and public interest requirements of that section and the  
4 Commission's procedures under that section, extend the  
5 time period during which the licensee is required to com-  
6 mence construction of the project so as to terminate on  
7 September 26, 1999.

8 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall take effect  
9 for the project described in subsection (a) upon the expira-  
10 tion of the extension, issued by the Commission under sec-  
11 tion 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), of the  
12 period required for commencement of construction of the  
13 project.

14 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If a li-  
15 cense for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-  
16 pired prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-  
17 mission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date  
18 of its expiration and extend the time required for com-  
19 mencement of construction of the project until September  
20 26, 1999.
