A BILL

To require random drug testing of Federal legislative branch officers and employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Legislative Branch
5 Drug Testing Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RANDOM DRUG TESTING IN LEGISLATIVE BRANCH.**

7 Each House of Congress, and each other entity with-
8 in the legislative branch, shall require random drug testing
9 of officers and employees within their respective bodies.
