A BILL

To achieve budgetary savings by reducing the funding and scope of the stockpile stewardship program of the Department of Energy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SEC. 1. REDUCTION IN FUNDING AND SCOPE OF DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF ENERGY STOCKPILE STEWARDSHIP**
5 **PROGRAM.**

6 (a) LIMITATIONS ON SPENDING.—The Secretary of
7 Energy may not spend for the stockpile stewardship pro-
8 gram—

9 (1) during fiscal year 1996, more than
10 \$1,409,000,000;

1 (2) during fiscal year 1997, more than
2 \$1,342,000,000;

3 (3) during fiscal year 1998, more than
4 \$1,244,000,000;

5 (4) during fiscal year 1999, more than
6 \$1,217,000,000; and

7 (5) during fiscal year 2000, more than
8 \$1,188,000,000.

9 (b) OFFSETTING REDUCTION IN SCOPE OF STOCK-
10 PILE STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM.—In order to achieve the
11 savings necessary to meet the spending limitations set
12 forth in subsection (a), the Secretary of Energy shall take
13 such measures as the Secretary considers appropriate to
14 reduce the scope of the stockpile stewardship program.
