3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR COMMISSARY**
4 **BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN PERSONS.**

5 Section 1064 of title 10, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking out “for 12 days each calendar year”
7 and inserting in lieu thereof “on the same basis as a per-
8 son who is eligible for such retired pay”.
