A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Trade Act of 1978 to eliminate the market promotion program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Market Promotion
5 Program Elimination Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF MARKET PROMOTION PROGRAM.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 203 of the Agricultural
8 Trade Act of 1978 (7 U.S.C. 5623) is repealed.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 211 of the
2 Agricultural Trade Act of 1978 (7 U.S.C. 5641) is amend-
3 ed by striking subsection (c).

4 (c) USE OF SAVINGS FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION.—
5 None of the changes in direct spending resulting from the
6 amendments made by this section shall be reflected in esti-
7 mates under section 252(d) of the Balanced Budget and
8 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

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
