3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Action Act
5 of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. UNLAWFUL CONDUCT.**

7 The use of race, sex, color, ethnicity, or national ori-
8 gin as a criterion for either discriminating against or

- 2 in employment, education, or contracting is unlawful.
