Mr. WYNN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee
on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of John Wesley Davis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.**

4 The time limitations set forth in section 3702(b) of
5 title 31, United States Code, shall not apply with respect
6 to a claim by John Wesley Davis, of Forestville, Maryland,
7 for the amounts due to him by the—

8 (1) Department of Veterans Affairs in the
9 amount of \$6,296.00;

10 (2) Department of the Navy in the amount of
11 \$42,123.84;

1 (3) Department of the Treasury in the amount
2 of \$12,508.20; and

3 (4) District of Columbia in the amount of
4 \$174.97 for local tax refund.

5 The amounts due are represented by checks that were re-
6 ceived but not negotiated by John Wesley Davis.

7 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE.**

8 Section 1 shall apply only if John Wesley Davis or
9 his authorized representative submits a claim pursuant to
10 such subsection before the expiration of the 6-month pe-
11 riod beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.
