A BILL

For the relief of John Wesley Davis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.**

4 The time limitations set forth in section 3702(b) of
5 title 31, United States Code, shall not apply with respect
6 to a claim by John Wesley Davis, of Forestville, Maryland,
7 for the amounts due to him by the—

1 (1) Department of Veterans Affairs in the
2 amount of \$6,296.00;

3 (2) Department of the Navy in the amount of
4 \$42,123.84;

5 (3) Department of the Treasury in the amount
6 of \$12,508.20; and

7 (4) District of Columbia in the amount of
8 \$174.97 for local tax refund.

9 The amounts due are represented by checks that were re-
10 ceived but not negotiated by John Wesley Davis.

11 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE.**

12 Section 1 shall apply only if John Wesley Davis or
13 his authorized representative submits a claim pursuant to
14 such subsection before the expiration of the 6-month pe-
15 riod beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.

16 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF TIME LIMITATIONS.**

17 *The time limitations set forth in section 3702(b) of*
18 *title 31, United States Code, shall not apply with respect*
19 *to a claim by John Wesley Davis, of Forestville, Maryland,*
