To suspend until January 1, 1998, the duty on certain
twine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TWINE.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

9902.56.07	3-ply twine, not braided or plaited, of nylon having a final 'S' twist; measuring less than 4.8mm in diameter; containing at least 10 percent cotton; made of 100 percent recycled materials (provided for in subheading 5607.50.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 【12/31/97】	..

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by section 1 shall apply with
3 respect to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse
4 for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date
5 of the enactment of this Act.
