1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “San Diego Coastal  
3 Corrections Act of 1995”.

4 **SEC. 2. COASTAL DISCHARGES.**

5 Section 304(d) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-  
6 trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1314(d)) is amended by adding at the  
7 end the following:

8 “(5) COASTAL DISCHARGES.—For purposes of  
9 this subsection, any municipal wastewater treatment  
10 facility shall be deemed the equivalent of a second-  
11 ary treatment facility if each of the following re-  
12 quirements is met:

13 “(A) The facility employs chemically en-  
14 hanced primary treatment.

15 “(B) The facility, on the date of the enact-  
16 ment of this paragraph, discharges through an  
17 ocean outfall into an open marine environment  
18 greater than 4 miles offshore into a depth  
19 greater than 300 feet.

20 “(C) The facility’s discharge is in compli-  
21 ance with all local and State water quality  
22 standards for the receiving waters.

23 “(D) The facility’s discharge will be sub-  
24 ject to an ocean monitoring program acceptable

1           to relevant Federal and State regulatory  
2           agencies.”.
