A BILL

To reduce the size of the House of Representatives to 295
Members.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPOSITION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENT-**
4 **ATIVES.**

5 Beginning with the first election occurring after the
6 next decennial census of the population, the House of Rep-
7 resentatives shall be composed of 295 Members to be ap-
8 portioned by the method known as the method of equal
9 proportions, no State to receive less than 1 Member.
