1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF GEORGE J. MITCHELL POST**
2 **OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 The United States Post Office building located at 33
4 College Avenue in Waterville, Maine, shall be known and
5 designated as the “George J. Mitchell Post Office
6 Building”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
10 States Post Office building referred to in section 1 shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “George J. Mitchell
12 Post Office Building”.
