3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4 Part IV of title III of the Communications Act of
5 1934 (47 U.S.C. 390 to 399b), relating to assistance for
6 public telecommunications facilities, telecommunications
7 demonstrations, and the Corporation for Public Broad-
8 casting, is repealed.
