## A BILL

To extend authorities under the Middle East Peace Facilitation Act of 1994 until October 1, 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITIES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 583(a) of the Foreign Re-  
5 lations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995  
6 (Public Law 103–236), as amended by Public Law 104–

1 17, is amended by striking “August 15, 1995,” and insert-  
2 ing “October 1, 1995,”.

3 (b) CONSULTATION.—For purposes of any exercise of  
4 the authority provided in section 583(a) of the Foreign  
5 Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995  
6 (Public Law 103–236) prior to August 16, 1995, the writ-  
7 ten policy justification dated June 1, 1995, and submitted  
8 to the Congress in accordance with section 583(b)(1) of  
9 such Act, and the consultations associated with such policy  
10 justification, shall be deemed to satisfy the requirements  
11 of section 583(b)(1) of such Act.
