A BILL

To provide for the return of economic resources for the imposition of certain customs fees and duties to the community in which the customs fees and duties are collected.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Community Develop-
5 ment Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.**

7 Title 19 of the United States Code is amended by
8 adding at the end thereof the following new section:

1 **“SEC. ____ . COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.**

2 “Not later than 90 days from the enactment of the
3 Community Development Act of 1995, the Secretary shall
4 promulgate regulations to provide for the return of 1 per
5 centum of the customs fees and duties assessed on a com-
6 modity under the provisions of this customs fees and du-
7 ties title to the port of entry, or airport of entry, that is
8 a public corporation as defined by 19 U.S.C. 81a(e) in
9 which the product was located at the time of assessment
10 of the customs fees and duties.”.

11 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

12 The provisions of this Act shall take effect upon en-
13 actment.
