## A BILL

To disapprove certain sentencing guideline amendments.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
4                       **EQUALIZATION OF CRACK AND COCAINE**  
5                       **POWDER QUANTITIES FOR TRAFFICKING OF-**  
6                       **FENSES.**

7       In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
8 States Code, Amendment number 5 of the “Amendments  
9 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
10 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-  
11 tencing Commission to Congress on May 1, 1995, is here-  
12 by disapproved and shall not take effect to the extent it—

1 (1) amends §2D1.1(c) (1) through (14) of the  
2 sentencing guidelines;

3 (2) inserts the following sentence in §2D1.1(c)  
4 of the sentencing guidelines: “ ‘Cocaine,’ for the  
5 purposes of this guideline, includes cocaine hydro-  
6 chloride, cocaine base, and crack cocaine.”; and

7 (3) deletes “1 gm of Cocaine Base (‘Crack’) =  
8 20 kg of marihuana” from the Commentary to  
9 §2D1.1 of the sentencing guidelines captioned “Ap-  
10 plication Notes” in Note 10 in the subdivision cap-  
11 tioned “Cocaine and Other Schedule I and II Stimu-  
12 lants”.

13 **SEC. 2. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
14 **EQUALIZATION OF CRACK AND COCAINE**  
15 **POWER QUANTITIES FOR POSSESSION OF-**  
16 **FENSES.**

17 In accordance with section 994(p) of title 28, United  
18 States Code, Amendment number 5 of the “Amendments  
19 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
20 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-  
21 tencing Commission to Congress on May 1, 1995, is here-  
22 by disapproved and shall not take effect to the extent it  
23 amends section 2D2.1.

1 **SEC. 3. DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS RELATING TO**  
2 **MONEY LAUNDERING AND TRANSACTIONS IN**  
3 **PROPERTY DERIVED FROM UNLAWFUL AC-**  
4 **TIVITY.**

6 States Code, Amendment number 18 of the “Amendments  
7 to the Sentencing Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Offi-  
8 cial Commentary”, submitted by the United States Sen-
