A BILL

To amend the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 to prevent the construction of a gas recovery treatment facility at the OII site east of downtown Los Angeles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF FUNDS FROM SUPERFUND PROHIBITED**

4 **FOR GAS RECOVERY TREATMENT FACILITY**

5 **AT OII SITE.**

6 Section 111 of the Comprehensive Environmental Re-
7 sponse, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 is
8 amended by adding the following at the end thereof:

1 “(q) USE OF FUNDS FOR GAS RECOVERY TREAT-
2 MENT AT OII SITE PROHIBITED.—No funds available in
3 the Hazardous Substances Superfund may be used for the
4 construction or operation of a gas recovery treatment fa-
5 cility at the site known as the OII landfill site, located
6 approximately 10 miles east of downtown Los Angeles and
7 covering 190 acres, divided by California Highway 60 (Po-
8 mona Freeway) and adjacent to the City of Montebello
9 on the South, and the City of Monterey Park on the
10 North.”.
