## A BILL

To extend the Administrative Conference of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION.**

4 The first sentence of section 596 of title 5, United  
5 States Code, is amended to read as follows: “There are  
6 authorized to be appropriated to carry out the purposes  
7 of this subchapter not more than \$1,800,000 for fiscal  
8 year 1995, \$1,800,000 for fiscal year 1996, \$1,800,000  
9 for fiscal year 1997, and \$1,800,000 for fiscal year  
10 1998.”.

1 **SEC. 2. MEMBERS' CAPACITY.**

2 Section 593(b) of title 5, United States Code, is  
3 amended by adding after and below paragraph (6) the fol-  
4 lowing: “The members appointed by the Chairman, with  
5 the approval of the Council, shall participate in the activi-  
6 ties of the Conference solely as private individuals without  
7 official responsibility on behalf of the Government of the  
8 United States and, therefore, shall not be considered to  
9 hold an office of profit or trust for purposes of the eighth  
10 clause of section 9 of Article I of the Constitution.”.

11 **SEC. 3. QUORUM.**

12 Section 595(a) of title 5, United States Code, is  
13 amended by adding after and below paragraph (2) the fol-  
14 lowing: “A majority of the members of the Conference  
15 shall constitute a quorum with regard to any final action  
16 taken under paragraph (1) or (2).”.

17 **SEC. 4. CHAIRMAN'S COMPENSATION.**

18 (a) EXECUTIVE SCHEDULE RATE.—Section  
19 593(b)(1) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by  
20 striking the period and the remainder of such section and  
21 inserting a semicolon and by adding after the matter  
22 added by section 2 the following: “The Chairman shall be  
23 paid at the rate specified for level III of the Executive  
24 Schedule and may continue to serve until the Chairman's  
25 successor is appointed and has qualified.”.

1           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 5314 of  
2 title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding at the  
3 end the following:

4                           “Chairman, Administrative Conference of  
5                           the United States.”.
