Mr. LAFALCE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To establish audit authority in the Comptroller of the State
of New York over the Niagara Falls Bridge Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 6 of the joint resolution entitled “Joint reso-
4 lution creating the Niagara Falls Bridge Commission and
5 authorizing said Commission and its successors to con-
6 struct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Niagara
7 River at or near the city of Niagara Falls, New York”,
8 approved June 16, 1938, as amended, is further amended
9 by adding the following:

1 “The Commission may be audited by the Comptroller
2 of the State of New York, at the Comptroller’s discretion,
3 under such conditions and procedures as may be pre-
4 scribed by the Comptroller, and for this purpose the
5 Comptroller shall have such access to all Commission
6 records as is necessary to facilitate the audit.”.
