A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Act of 1949 to clarify the prevented planting rule for the calculation of crop acreage bases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EFFECT OF PREVENTED PLANTING ON CAL-**
4 **CULATION OF CROP ACREAGE BASES.**

5 Section 503(f) of the Agricultural Act of 1949 (7
6 U.S.C. 1463(f)) is amended—

7 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “on the
8 acreage of such farm” and all that follows through
9 the period at the end of the sentence and inserting
10 “on the failed acreage or any other acreage of the

1 farm consistent with the conservation plan for the
2 farm prepared in accordance with section 1212 of
3 the Food Security Act of 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3812).”;
4 and

5 (2) in the second sentence—

6 (A) by inserting after “subsection” the fol-
7 lowing: “(but not to exceed the total of the
8 failed acreage)”; and

9 (B) by striking “such acreage” and insert-
10 ing “the substitute acreage”.
