## A BILL

To allow for a waiver during non-ozone season of certain reformulated gas requirements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN REFORMULATED GAS RE-**  
4 **QUIREMENTS.**

5 Section 211(k) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.  
6 7545(k)) is amended by adding the following at the end  
7 thereof:

8 “(11) NON-OZONE SEASON WAIVER.—Upon the  
9 request of the Governor of a State, the Adminis-  
10 trator shall waive the prohibition set forth in para-

1 graph (5) during the non-ozone season, as defined  
2 by the Administrator, for any area designated as an  
3 ozone nonattainment area, if the Administrator de-  
4 termines that the waiver would not prevent or inter-  
5 fere with the attainment of a primary national ambi-  
6 ent air quality standard in such area.”.
