To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to eliminate certain requirements on States under the medicaid program with respect to minimum reimbursement levels for hospitals, nursing facilities, and intermediate care facilities.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS ON**
2 **STATES WITH RESPECT TO MINIMUM LEVELS**
3 **OF PROVIDER REIMBURSEMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the So-
5 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(13)(A)) is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) by striking “in the case of nursing facili-
8 ties” and all that follows through “nursing care, and
9 which,”; and

10 (2) by striking “1861(v)(1)(G)) which the
11 State finds,” and all that follows through “services
12 of adequate quality;” and inserting
13 “1861(v)(1)(G));”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
15 subsection (a) shall take effect on January 1, 1996.

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
