For the relief of Jacqueline Darby-Maltbie.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CREDIT FOR EMPLOYMENT AS A FOREIGN NA-**
4 **TIONAL.**

5 Notwithstanding section 2105 of title 5, United
6 States Code, Jacqueline Darby-Maltbie of New Orleans,
7 Louisiana, shall be treated as a Federal employee for pur-
8 poses of civil service retirement, for the 9-year period of
9 employment with the Federal Government as a foreign na-
10 tional employee in Athens, Greece, and London, England.
