## A BILL

To rescind the fee required for the use of public recreation areas at lakes and reservoirs under the jurisdiction of the Army Corps of Engineers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESCISSION OF RECREATIONAL USER FEES.**

4 Section 210(b) of the Flood Control Act of 1968 (16  
5 U.S.C. 460d-3(b)) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(b) USER FEES.—User fees at the lakes and res-  
7ervoirs referred to in subsection (a) shall be collected by  
8 officers and employees of the United States only from  
9 users of highly developed facilities requiring continuous

1 presence of personnel for maintenance and supervision of  
2 the facilities and shall not be collected for access to or  
3 use of water areas, beaches, picnic grounds, overlook sites,  
4 scenic drives, or boat launching ramps.”.
