Mr. MARKEY (for himself, Mr. FALCOMAVAEGA, and Mr. STARK) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on International Relations, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To increase by 800 percent the duty on imports of beaujolais wine that is the product of France.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN DUTY ON BEAUJOLAIS WINE**

4 **THAT IS THE PRODUCT OF FRANCE.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the rate
6 of duty on beaujolais wine, provided for in subheading
7 2204.21.50 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
8 United States, that is the product of France shall be the

1 rate equal to the rate of such duty that would apply but
2 for this section, multiplied by 800 percent.

3 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 Section 1 shall apply with respect to goods entered,
5 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

7 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION.**

8 The increase in duty provided for in section 1 shall
9 apply until the President certifies to the Congress that the
10 Government of France has terminated its underground
11 nuclear test program and begun dismantling its nuclear
12 testing facilities in the South Pacific.
