A BILL

To amend the provisions of title 5, United States Code, that provide for a 2 percent reduction in retirement benefits for each year that the employee is under age 55 at the time of retiring.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.**

4 Section 8339(h) of title 5, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by striking “(h) The” inserting “(h)(1)

7 Subject to paragraph (2), the”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(2) In the case of an employee who separates on
2 or after the date of the enactment of this paragraph, and
3 who is at least 50 years of age as of the date of separation,
4 the first sentence of paragraph (1) shall be applied by sub-
5 stituting for ‘ $\frac{1}{6}$ ’ a fraction determined as follows:

“If, as of the date of separation, the employee is—	The applicable fraction is—
At least 50 but less than 51 years of age	$\frac{7}{48}$
At least 51 but less than 52 years of age	$\frac{1}{8}$
At least 52 but less than 53 years of age	$\frac{1}{12}$
At least 53 but less than 54 years of age	$\frac{1}{16}$
At least 54 but less than 55 years of age	$\frac{1}{24}$.”.
