A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF COMMENCEMENT OF CON-**
2 **STRUCTION DEADLINE FOR HYDROELECTRIC**
3 **PROJECT IN THE STATE OF ILLINOIS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding the time period
5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
6 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
7 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 3246, the
8 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the
9 project, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,
10 and public interest requirements of that section and the
11 Commission's procedures under that section, extend until
12 October 15, 2001, the time period during which the li-
13 censee is required to commence construction of the
14 project.

15 (b) **APPLICABILITY.**—Subsection (a) shall take effect
16 on the expiration of the extension, issued by the Commis-
17 sion under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
18 806), of the period required for commencement of con-
19 struction of the project described in subsection (a).

20 (c) **REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.**—If the
21 license for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-
22 pired prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-
23 mission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date
24 of its expiration and extend until October 15, 2001, the
25 time required for commencement of construction of the
26 project.

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF COMMENCEMENT OF CON-**

4 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—Notwithstanding the time period
5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
6 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Reg-
7 ulatory Commission project numbered 3246, the Commis-
8 sion shall, at the request of the licensee for the project, in
9 accordance with the good faith, due diligence, and public
10 interest requirements of that section and the Commission's
11 procedures under that section, extend until October 15,
12 1997, the time period during which the licensee is required
13 to commence construction of the project.

14 (b) *APPLICABILITY.*—Subsection (a) shall take effect on
15 the expiration of the extension, issued by the Commission
16 under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806),
17 of the period required for commencement of construction of
18 the project described in subsection (a).

19 (c) *REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE.*—The Commission is
20 authorized to reinstate the license for the project referred
21 to in subsection (a), effective as of the date of its expiration
22 or termination.
