A BILL

To permit private persons to place symbols meaningful to them, including religious symbols, in public places in cases where all persons have the right to do so.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Religious Symbols
5 Fairness Act of 1995”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF RIGHTS.**

7 A private person shall have the right to place, at that
8 person’s own expense, symbols meaningful to that person,
9 including religious symbols, on public space, including gov-

1 ernment buildings, to the extent the governmental author-
2 ity controlling the space allows all private persons the
3 same right.
