A BILL

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of certain hydroelectric projects in the State of Pennsylvania.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.**

4 (a) EXTENSION.—Notwithstanding the time limita-
5 tions of section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
6 806), upon the request of the licensee for the project con-
7 cerned, and after reasonable notice, the Federal Energy
8 Regulatory Commission is authorized, in accordance with
9 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest require-
10 ments of such section 13 and the Commission's procedures

1 under such section, to extend the time required for com-
2 mencement of construction of each the following projects
3 until April 15, 2001:

4 (1) FERC Project No. 4474.

5 (2) FERC Project No. 7401.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect
7 for the project upon the expiration of the extension (issued
8 by the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power
9 Act (16 U.S.C. 806)) of the period required for commence-
10 ment of construction of the project concerned.
