A BILL

To repeal restrictive provisions of Federal law relating to
colored margarine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COLORED MARGARINE.**

4 (a) FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT.—

5 (1) SECTION 301.—Paragraph (m) of section
6 301 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act
7 (21 U.S.C. 331) is repealed.

8 (2) SECTION 407.—Section 407 of the Federal
9 Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 347) is
10 repealed.

1 (b) FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION ACT.—Section 15
2 of the Federal Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 55) is
3 amended—

4 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “(a)(1)” and
5 inserting “(a)” and by striking paragraph (2), and
6 (2) by repealing subsection (f).

7 (c) ACT OF MARCH 16, 1950.—Sections 3(a) and 6
8 of the Act of March 16, 1950 (21 U.S.C. 347a, 347b)
9 are repealed.
