AN ACT

To amend the Clean Air Act to provide that traffic signal synchronization projects are exempt from certain requirements of Environmental Protection Agency Rules.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION. 1. TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYNCHRONIZATION**
2 **PROJECTS.**

3 Section 176(c)(4) (42 U.S.C. 7506(c)(4)) of the
4 Clean Air Act is amended by adding the following at the
5 end thereof:

6 “(D) Compliance with the rules of the Administrator
7 for determining the conformity of transportation plans,
8 programs, and projects funded or approved under title 23
9 of the United States Code or the Federal Transit Act to
10 State or Federal implementation plans shall not be re-
11 quired for traffic signal synchronization projects prior to
12 the funding, approval or implementation of such projects.
13 The supporting regional emissions analysis for any con-
14 formity determination made with respect to a transpor-
15 tation plan, program, or project shall consider the effect
16 on emissions of any such project funded, approved, or im-
17 plemented prior to the conformity determination.”.
